Gosport & Fareham Singles Competitions Rules

The Singles Competitions are:

- **Audrey Pearce Trophy**
 - For any constituent Club Member BE-registered to compete in the Women's category
- **Masterman Trophy**
 - For any constituent Club Member BE-registered to compete in the Men's category
- **Presidents' Cup**
 - For current and all past Presidents of constituent Clubs, and of the League
- **Secretaries' / Treasurers' Shield**
 - For current and all past Secretaries/Treasurers of constituent Clubs, and of the League
- **Bowler of the Year Trophy**
 - Each constituent Club is permitted to nominate two players (one each from those BE-registered to compete in the Women's category and in the Men's category) for this competition. Those selected should, in the opinion of the Club, have done the most for that club during the season, rather than because they are the best bowlers.

The winner of each match will be the first to **21 shots**.

The first named player in the tie will be the challenger, and will have the advantage of being at home. **The challenger must offer his/her opponent at least two dates within seven days of the draw being issued, otherwise the challenged person shall become the challenger and assume the advantages of the challenger.**

Matches must be played by the scheduled date for each round of the competition, and failure to do so may result in the disqualification from the competition of one or both players.

All competitions' final matches will occur concurrently on Finals Day, with its date highlighted on the competition entry forms.

Any bowler entered in any G & F League Singles Competition who finds that they are unable to play on Finals Day must withdraw from the competition before its quarter-final.

In accordance with the League's Data Protection Policy, entrants' names and contact information will be collected and used in the management of these competitions. Entrant names may also be displayed on the League's website, and contact information will be shared with other entrants in order for matches to be arranged.

The Rules were approved by the members present at the Annual General Meeting of the League, in Nov 2015. Extracts from the League's Data Protection Policy and BE definitions were adopted following the Executive Committee meeting in Mar 2022.
